


Carl Siepen CONSENSUS YEA AND NAY

Without consensus, there can be no common policy. An understanding of the other stakeholders in the conversation contributes to the forging of consensus. Try to predict the whole group of players' opinion on various EU policy topics. The earlier you decide, the more points you can win – or lose if your prediction is wrong. The aim of the game is to correctly predict the group's opinion on the various issues as soon as possible.

CONTENTS

Fold the question cards and ballots on the double lines and cut them out on the dotted lines. Sort the cards: there are three cards for each policy topic. If more than five persons want to play the game, make additional ballots for each person. The vote is taken on the parliament sheet. The total number of points are determined and written in the counting table. The game provides enough material for 25 rounds. Print on one side only.

GAMEPLAY

Before beginning, decide whether you would like to play for a specific number of rounds or a length of time. Next, select a political issue and turn one card face up in each of the first three rounds. Read the text aloud. Each of you decides what you think the voting result will be and then puts your ballot face down on the parliament sheet. Per issue, you may only vote once with "yes" or "no". Once you have decided, you must submit dummy ballots in the following rounds to keep the vote a secret. If you are not sure about an issue, you can submit a dummy ballot first and listen to further arguments until you are certain of how you want to vote.

The players who can guess the voting result before the first card is turned face up will submit their ballot in round 0. As each player is trying to guess the group's voting result, your ballot does not necessarily have to reflect your personal opinion.

Evaluation

After all three cards on one topic have been turned face up and all players have submitted their ballots, the ballots are turned face up and counted. Now you can find out which one of you correctly guessed the group's consensus and who receives or loses points. Record the point totals in the counting table. In this example, player A loses five points, player B wins 30, and player C wins 10 points.


